Root Canal Therapy

Post-Operative Instructions for Root Canal Therapy:

- 1. If medications have been prescribed to you, take them as instructed.
- 2. Mild to moderate sensitivity on the tooth, gums, or injection site is normal and may last up to several weeks.
- 3. Take the prescription analgesic if it was prescribed for you. Otherwise, taking Motrin (400mg) and Tylenol (1000mg) in combination is a very effective analgesic, and may be taken up to 4 times per day.
- 3. Avoid chewing hard and/or sticky foods as well as flossing vigorously around the treated tooth. This may dislodge your temporary.
- 4. If sensitivity persists, is severe, or you have problems with your temporary, please call us.
