Veneers

Congratulations for choosing to cosmetically enhance your smile using *porcelain veneers*! Porcelain veneers are use to reshape, align and brighten a persons smile in a very conservative manner. You will soon have the dazzling smile you always wanted.

Post-operative instructions for Veneers:

Initial Preparation Visit:

- 1. Your temporaries are delicate, so take precautions to avoid breakage, discoloring or de-bonding.
- 2. Avoid chewing hard and/or sticky foods, hard brushing and flossing between your temporaries.
- 3. As the temporaries are porous, avoid staining foods and drinks such as coffee, wine, curry.
- 4. Rinse with warm salt-water or medicated rinse twice daily while you are in your temporaries.
- 5. Sensitivity is normal following treatment. Motrin(400mg) and Tylenol(1000mg) taken together acts as a very effective analysesic and may be taken up to 4 times per day.
 - 6. If you have severe discomfort, or have any problems with the temporary please call us.

"Cementation" visit

- 1. The bonding agent "cement" used takes 48 hours to fully harden. Be cautious during this time.
- 2. Sensitivity following this visit is normal, and may last several weeks. Please take medicine as listed above.
- 3. If sensitivity persists, is severe, or your bite feels uncomfortable, please call us.
- 4. If you have been prescribed a nightguard, please make sure you wear it daily to preserve your restorations.
